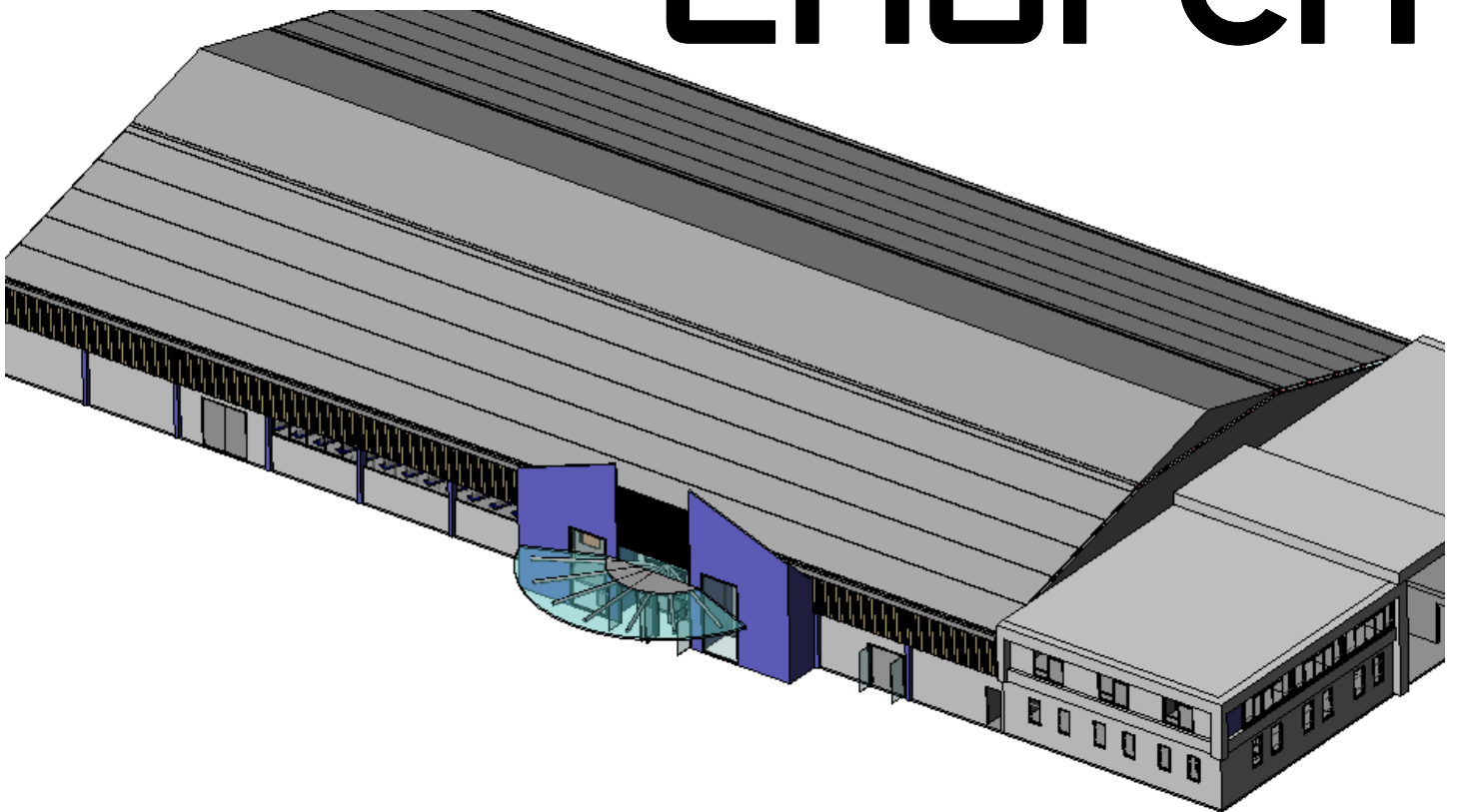
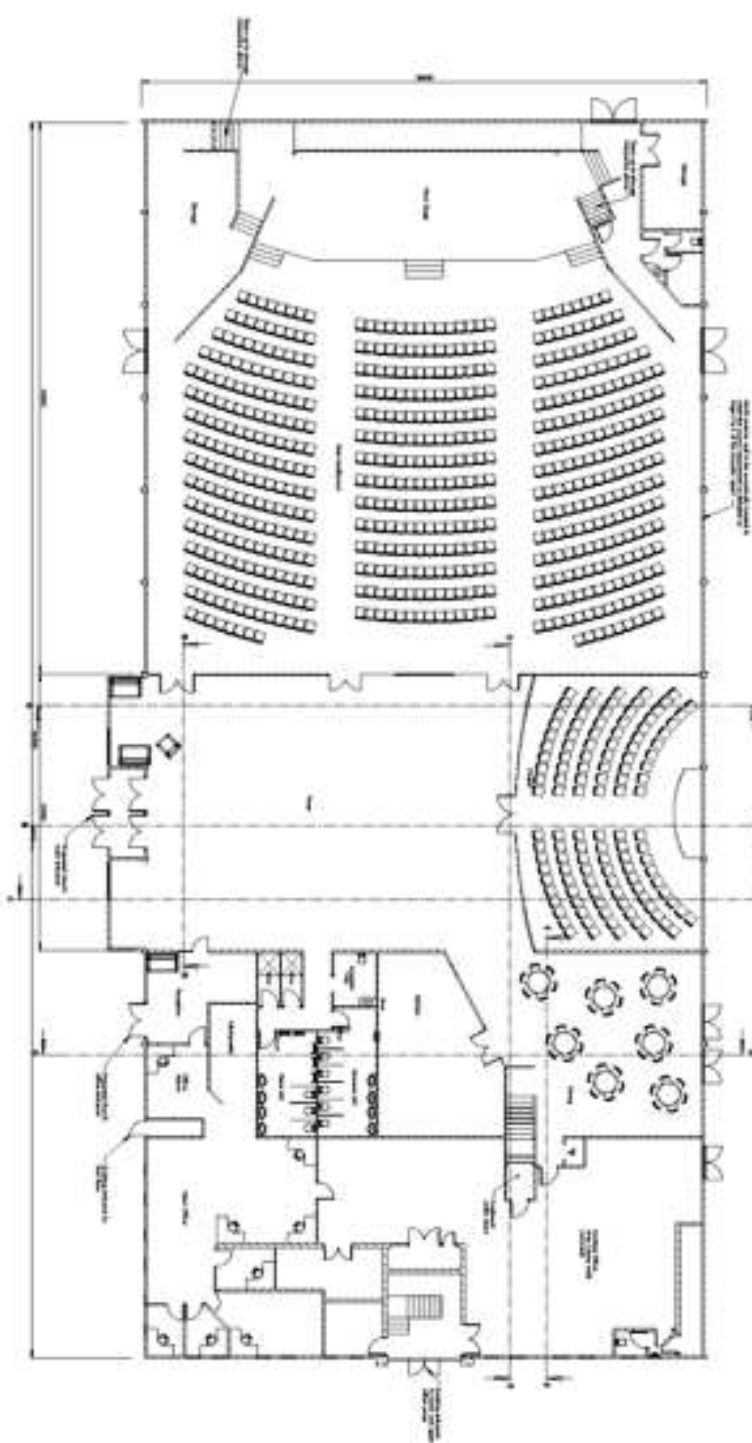




OUR New church

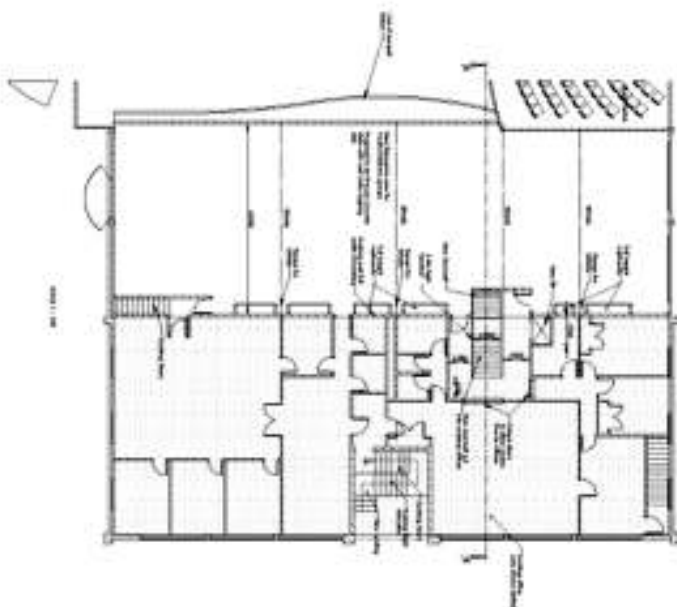




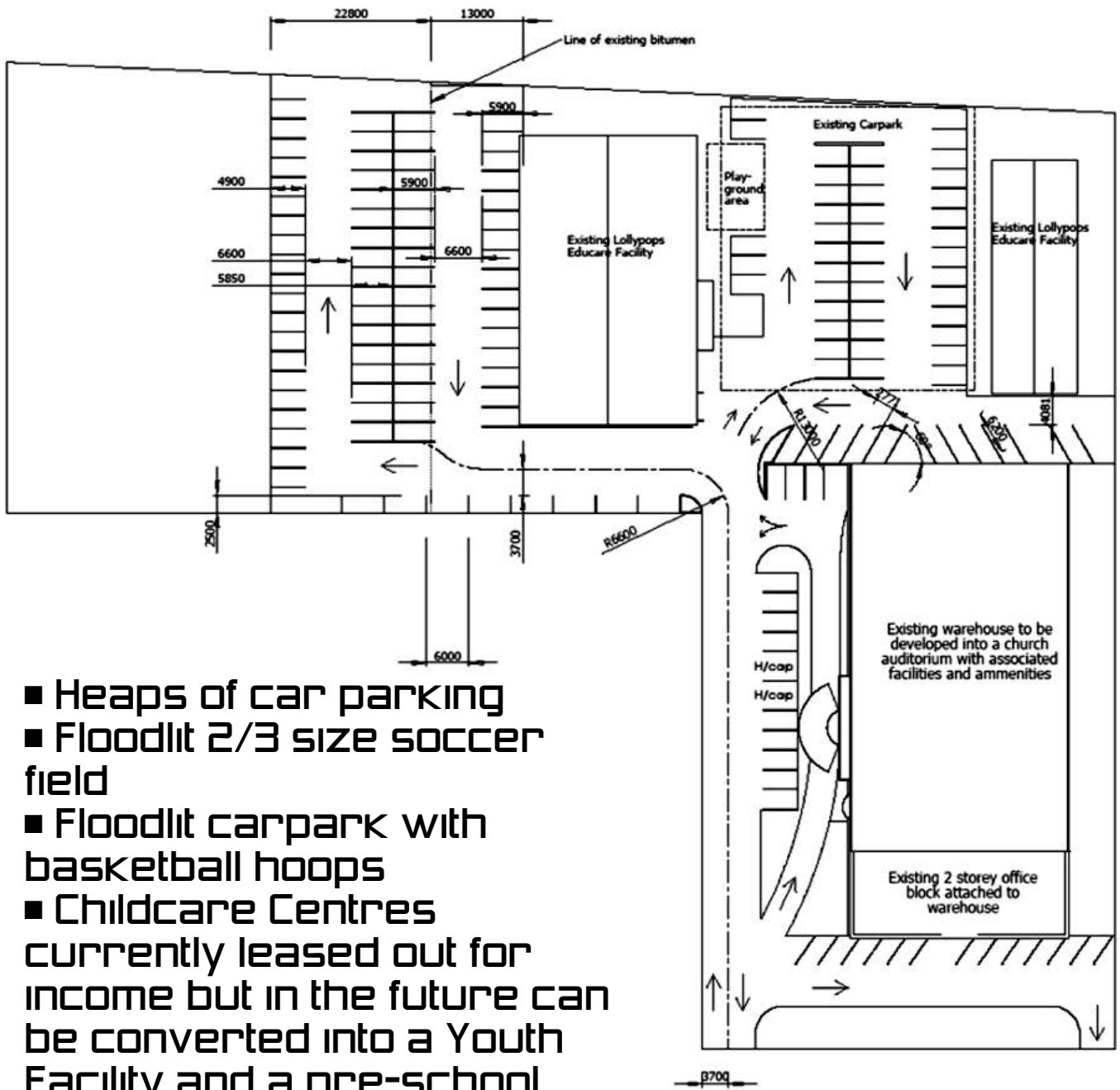
- 600 seat auditorium

QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE

How will the buildings be used?

We want to continue to see Sunday church as the tip of the ice berg! These buildings will also be used for Youth programs 4 nights per week, subsidised counseling services, men's groups, ladies groups, sports (indoor bowls to soccer!), mum's play groups, children's programs, bands, cultural groups, dance groups, community meals, one off events such as the light party and drive in movies, and for other community organisations. And that is just what we have operating currently! There is potential to significantly expand what we do in our community and for our community through these facilities!

When will we get to Lambie Dr?

Construction will begin in August 2008. This will be a 5-6 month construction process.

How much will it cost?

The net debt for the church will be over \$2 million dollars on the cost of the purchase of the site and the development costs of the site.

Where will the money come from?

We are not interested in carrying an unsustainable or crippling debt as a church. We are here to do ministry and our buildings are a tool to do that.

When we move in to Lambie, our income from the Childcare centres will service the interest cost for the debt on the property. The church will have responsibility for paying off the principal.

There is Trust funding from places such as the ASB Trust (\$100k) and others which we will be applying for.

There is also us! You can contribute to this project. It simply comes down to this: if we want this to happen, we will need to make personal financial contributions to this project.

How long will "the childcare centres" be there for?

ABC has a long term lease for the next 15 years, which will provide income to service the debt on Lambie Drive. Currently, a real estate company is also leasing upstairs offices at Lambie. This will provide further income for us without sacrificing too much floor space.

What can I do for now?

1. PRAY!

Pray for good decisions throughout the project and for the right people we need to make this project work.

Pray for our finance – for wise expenditure, for funding from Trusts and for our own contributions.

Pray and thank God for where we are at, and what he wants to do through us all in our community of Manukau.

2. GET EXCITED! – it will be awesome to have our own buildings again!

3. CONTRIBUTE – God's economy is different to the rest of the world's! God sees **YOUR** contribution as just as important as someone who gave \$100,000. Whacky, but true! So we see your contribution as just as important as anyone else's too! We'd love you to move into the new church and say: "God used me to make this happen! I prayed for it, I got excited about it and I helped financially too!"
